

Kindergarten Readiness: The Basics

- Following 2 step directions
- Sharing and taking turns
- Using the bathroom independently and then washing own hands
- Managing strong emotions
- Zippers, buttons, shoelaces and if required, masks
- Taking responsibility (ex. If you spill something, clean it up)





"Scientists have discovered that it takes approximately 400 repetitions to create a new synapse in the brain, unless done in play, in which case it only takes 10-20 repetitions"





Kindergarten Readiness:

Playfully and Joyfully:

- Practice saying, recognizing, and writing your name
- Trace and name letters
- Count to 20 and recognizing numbers 0-10
- Name colors
- Read together and connect with books through shared life experiences
- Read/Sing nursery rhymes and tongue twisters
- Talk, Talk, Talk
